Compost waste deared

Lanes Group drainage engineers used breathing apparatus to enter a section of one of the UK's largest residual household waste treatment facilities, operated by Amey, and clear more than 170t of organic waste.

The job involved deploying a jetting and vacumation vehicle called a DISAB Centurion, which has a liquid ring pump, giving it additional suction power over long hose runs.

The machine is capable of removing a large variety of waste, including powders, ash, granular material, sludge and aggregates, even rubble. A standard jet vac tanker worked alongside the DISAB to provide water jetting.

Testing time for fall arrestors

Latchways has developed two different test rigs as part of its rigorous programme to confirm the quality of its fall arrest products. Both rigs use TorqSense transducers from Sensor Technology as the main means of measuring the critical test parameters.

TorqSense is an easy-to-use, noncontact sensor. Normally, to measure torque, delicate slip rings have to be used between the rotating shaft and the stationary sensor. However, TorqSense does not require this; instead, it is simply mounted close to the test piece and takes its reading via a radio frequency signal, which it bounces off the shaft.

The returning signal has its frequency changed in proportion to the torque, due to a pair of tiny piezoelectric combs glued onto the shaft, which distort, due to the



rotation of the shaft.
